

Cambridge (Blue) English Trail



1. Cambridge Guildhall - Begin on the south side of Market Hill (the market square in the city) where you will find the Guildhall. Find the main entrance to the building.



2. Great St Mary's Church - With your backs to the entrance of the Guildhall, travel in a clockwise direction to follow the path around the market square. Turn left on to St Mary's Passage, where you will see the church.



3. 3D Model - Senate House Hill - Outside the main doors to Great St Mary's Church you will find a bronze 3D model of Cambridge city.



4. Trinity Street - Walk along Senate House Hill towards Trinity Street. Stop at the point where Trinity Street and St Mary's Street meet to answer question number 4.



5. St John's Street - With the Cambridge University Press bookshop on your right, continue walking down Trinity Street until you reach St John's Street. The map you need to locate to answer question number 5 is on the opposite side of the road - take care when crossing.



6. Trumpington Street - Walk back down St John's Street and Trinity Street (travelling in the opposite direction you have just walked). Continue walking down King's Parade, passing Kings College. The blue plaque you need locate to answer question 6 is attached to a King's College building on the west side of Trumpington Street.



7. Corpus Clock - The clock is located at the junction of Bene't Street and Trumpington Street, looking out over King's Parade. Take care when crossing the road!

It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
