Cambridge (Green) English Trail



1. Castle Mound — Parking can be found at Shire Hall on Castle Street. Begin the trail at Castle Mound which is situated on a knoll called Castle Hill. Follow the footpath that takes you back down to the main road (Castle Street).

2. Museum of Cambridge - Continue down Castle Street until you reach the road crossing. Cross the road to the Museum of Cambridge. Locate the blue plaque.





3. Cambridge Core Sculpture - Use the crossing to cross Northampton Street then use a second crossing to cross Magdalene Street. The Core Sculpture is on this crossroads.

4. The Round Church - Continue along Magdalene Street. Look out for the Round Church which will be on your left.





5. ADC Theatre - Walk along Round Church Street and turn right at the junction. The ADC Theatre will be on your right.

6. All Saints Passage - After locating the theatre, turn right at the junction. Cross Bridge Street and continue along All Saints Passage. Look out for a 'dinky door' at the end of the passage.





7. Michaelhouse Centre - Turn left out of All Saints Passage and walk along Trinity Street until you reach the Michaelhouse Centre.

8. The Eagle, Bene't Street - Continue walking along Trinity Street and then on to Senate House Hill which eventually becomes Kings Parade. Turn left onto Bene't Street where you will reach The Eagle public house.



It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions shown.
