

Chatteris English Trail



1 The Library—Parking is available in Furrowfields Road, adjacent to the library, if needed. Start at the Library on Furrowfields Road and turn left upon exiting the library, towards High Street. At the High Street junction, turn left and walk towards the small roundabout. Continue past the roundabout then immediately cross High Street into Jubilee Gardens.

2. Jubilee Gardens—Exit Jubilee Gardens onto High Street and continue walking for approximately 80m until you arrive at the junction with King Edwards Road. On the opposite side of the road you will see Bramley House.



3. The Bramley House—Continue heading south as the road becomes Market Hill and after approximately 40m you will find yourself opposite the church of St Peter and St Paul. Cross the road onto the area in front of the church.

4. St Peter and St Paul's Church—Return to Market Hill and continue south, crossing Church Lane and East Park Street into the cobbled Community Band Stand Area after approximately 100m.



5. Community Bandstand—Continue along East Park Street, across St Martin's Road and Belmont Gardens on your left. At Allen's Yard, stop following East Park Street (which forks to the right) and continue straight ahead onto Wenny Road until you see the gated entrance on

6. Wenny Road Recreation Ground - This might make an ideal outdoor break area at the end of the trail for children to have a snack and drink before returning to school with the information they have gathered.



It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
