Ely English Trail



1. Oliver Cromwell's House — Parking is available at Barton Road or Fore Hill car parks, amongst others. Start facing Oliver Cromwell's House, in St Mary's Street. Turn left and walk along Church Lane for approximately 60m to view St Mary's Church.

2. St Mary's Church — Follow the path towards the cathedral grounds, heading east for approximately 200m. You should pass the cannon on your way.





3. Ely Cathedral — Facing the entrance to the cathedral, walk in a clockwise direction around the footpath of Steeple Row until you find a path on the right. After approximately 200m this will lead you out onto High Street, through the Sacrist Gate. You may wish to cross over the High Street for a better view.

4. Sacrist Gate — Facing Sacrist Gate, turn left and head East along High Street for approximately 40m to the War Memorial, which is opposite the Market Place.





5. Market Place — Continue East along High Street leading into Fore Hill for approximately 170m. Turn left onto Waterside and proceed for a further 300m. (Do not cross over the river.)

6. Great Ouse Riverside — Proceed along the riverside, keeping the River Ouse on your left hand side. Walk in a south westerly direction for approximately 400m until you reach Jubilee Gardens on your right hand side.





7. Jubilee Gardens — Find the Eel Sculpture and then walk towards Broad Street.

The Bandstand and seating area might make a good place for a snack and drink break at the end of the trail.

It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
