

March English Trail



1. St Peter's Church — Parking close by is available in City Road Car Park, if needed. Start at St Peter's Church on the B1101, which is just north of the roundabout junction with Burrowmoor Road. Almost directly opposite St Peter's Church you will find the Museum. Take care when crossing over the road.



2. Museum — Walk approximately 150m north into town, along the B1101. Just before you reach the Market Place/Town Hall, you will see Ye Old Griffin Hotel — cross over the road to it.



3. Ye Old Griffin Hotel — Cross over the road into the Market Square.



4. Market Place/Town Hall— Continue into town along the B1101 and cross the road (pedestrian crossing) after the bridge over the Old River Nene, onto Broad Street. Continue walking north along Broad Street for approximately 200m and you will see the Fountain on the island in the middle of the road. This is accessible by foot using the pedestrian crossing.



5. Fountain — Retrace your route back along Broad Street for approximately 70m past the bus shelter on your right. Immediately after crossing the bridge over the Old River Nene, you will see a footbath on your right which takes you along the river, through the sensory gardens, to the library.



6. Library — From the library, continue along the riverside pathway into West End Park.



7. West End Park — This might make an ideal outdoor break area at the end of the trail for children to have a snack and drink before returning to school with the information they have gathered.

It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
