

Peterborough English Trail



1. Lido — Start in the Lido Gardens. Cross Bishop's Road using the pedestrian crossing and turn left walking alongside Bishop's Road Gardens on your right. The entrance can be found on your right, after approximately 100m.



2. Bishop's Road Gardens — Exit the gardens and turn right. Walk along the path for approximately 270m, taking care when crossing the entrance to the Car Haven car park. You will also cross over St Peter's Road. Turn up Bridge Street and head north towards the Town Hall, which you will find after approximately 250m.



3. Town Hall — Just up from the Town Hall, you will find the War Memorial in the middle of Bridge Street.



4. War Memorial — Continue north on Bridge Street for approximately 30m until you reach Cathedral Square. The Guildhall can be found in the middle of the old Market Place on your left.



5. Cathedral Square / The Guildhall — Continue along Exchange Street, heading east, and ensuring Peterborough Parish Church is on your left, behind the railings, and Miss Pears is on your right. A plaque can be found on the East face of the Miss Pears building, confirming the identity of the building.



6. Peterborough Parish Church / Miss Pears — Walk back across Cathedral Square towards the entrance to the Cathedral, for approximately 500m.



7. Cathedral — You are able to circumnavigate the Cathedral on foot in either direction. This might make a suitable place for a drink and/or a short break, if desired.

It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
