

## St Ives English Trail

**1. Bus Station** - Start at the Bus Station and use the information on the town plan board to answer the first question. Then exit the bus station onto Market Road.

**2. Market Hill** - Turn left on Market Road and walk to the junction. At the crossing on your right, cross the road on to Market Hill. Stop at the circular timeline and answer question 2.





**3. The Free Church & Oliver Cromwell Statue**- Continue along Market Hill until you get to the Oliver Cromwell Statue and the Free Church URC. Answer question 3.

**4.** The Quay - Next to the Free Church, you will find Free Church Passage. Walk along this path until you reach The Quay. Find The Quay Information Board to answer question 4.





**5. The Bridge** - Turn right and walk along the quayside until you reach the historic bridge at the end of Bridge Street. Turn left to walk onto the bridge and stop at the wooden door in the middle of the bridge. Answer question 5 before walking back towards Bridge Street.



**6. Bridge Street** - Continue along Bridge Street and stop at the shopfront on the left which displays "A History of the Old Riverport of St Ives" in the window. Answer question 6 then continue along Bridge Street before turning left on to Merryland.



**7. The Broadway** - Continue along Merryland until you reach The Broadway. Stop at The Broadway Information Board and The Victoria Memorial. Answer question 7.



**8. The Waits** - Continue west along The Broadway until you reach the Norris Museum and The Waits. You will find an information board and benches. Answer question 8.





**9. Pilgrims Rest Cottages**— Continue along the road as it bends around to the right. Then turn right onto North Road. Bear right and then turn left onto East Street. Stop at the Pilgrims Rest cottages on the left and answer question 9. You can now turn left onto Crown Walk to finish the trail at Warners Park, or continue down East Street back to the Bus Station.
