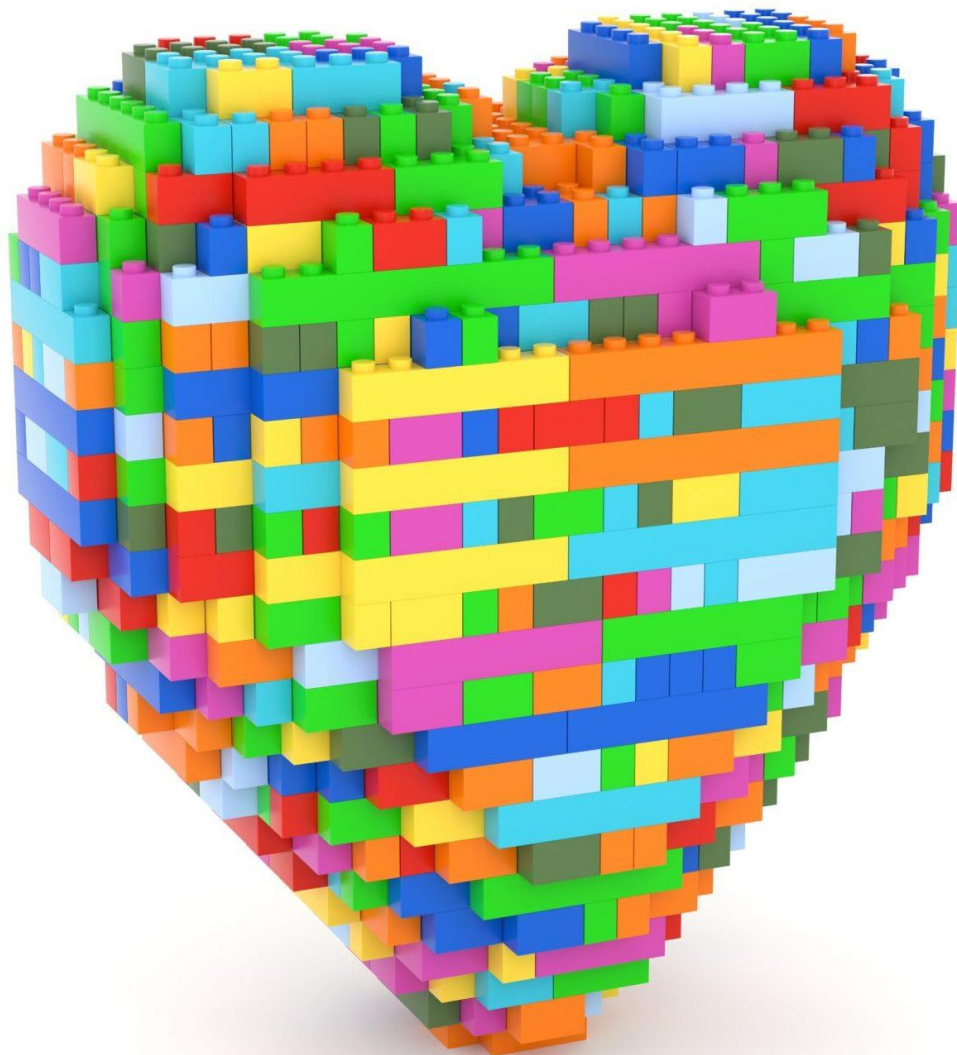

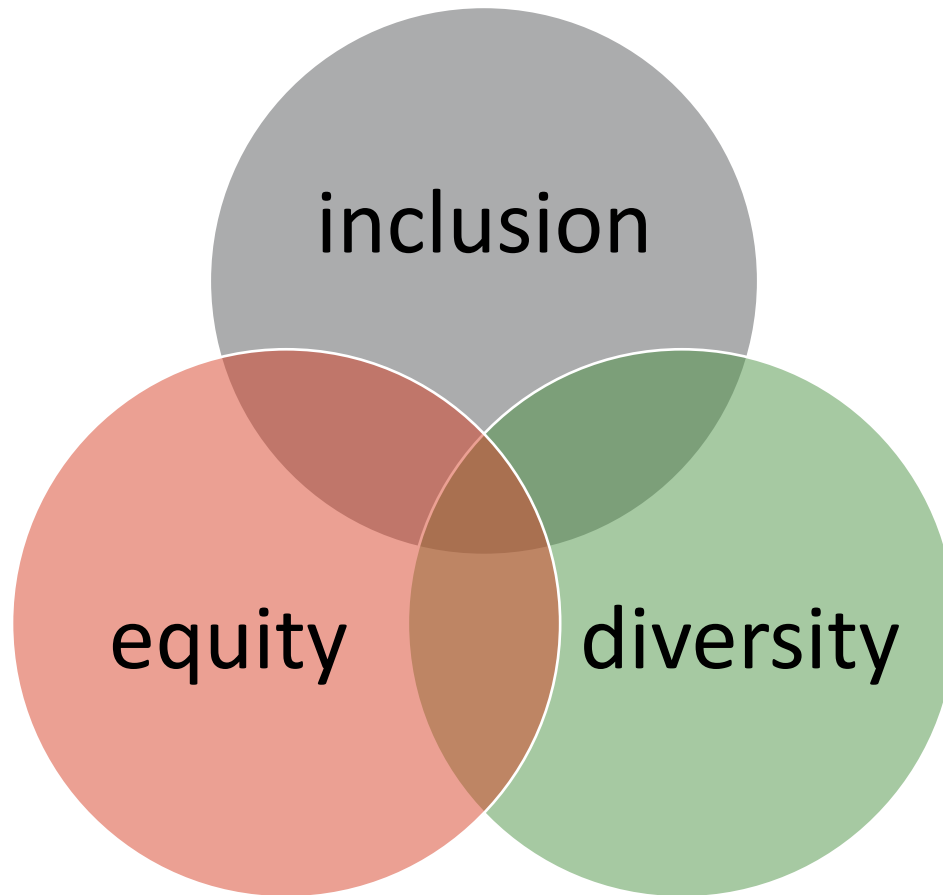

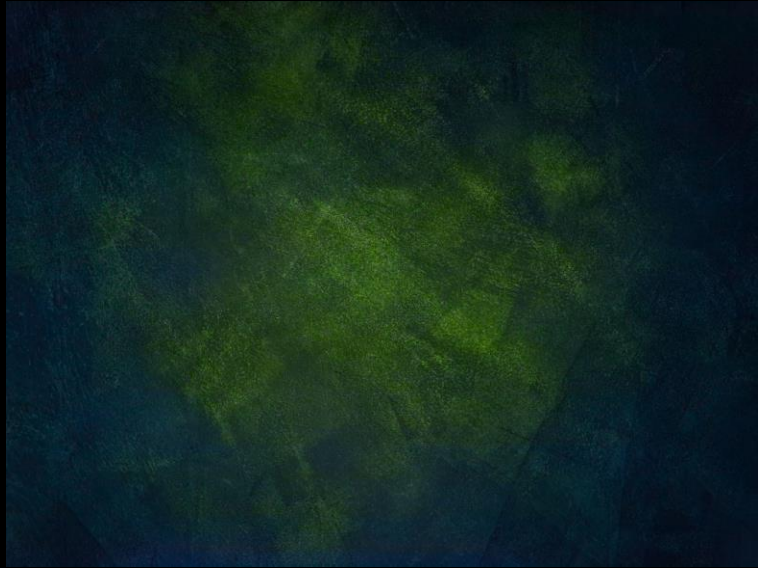

Prioritise

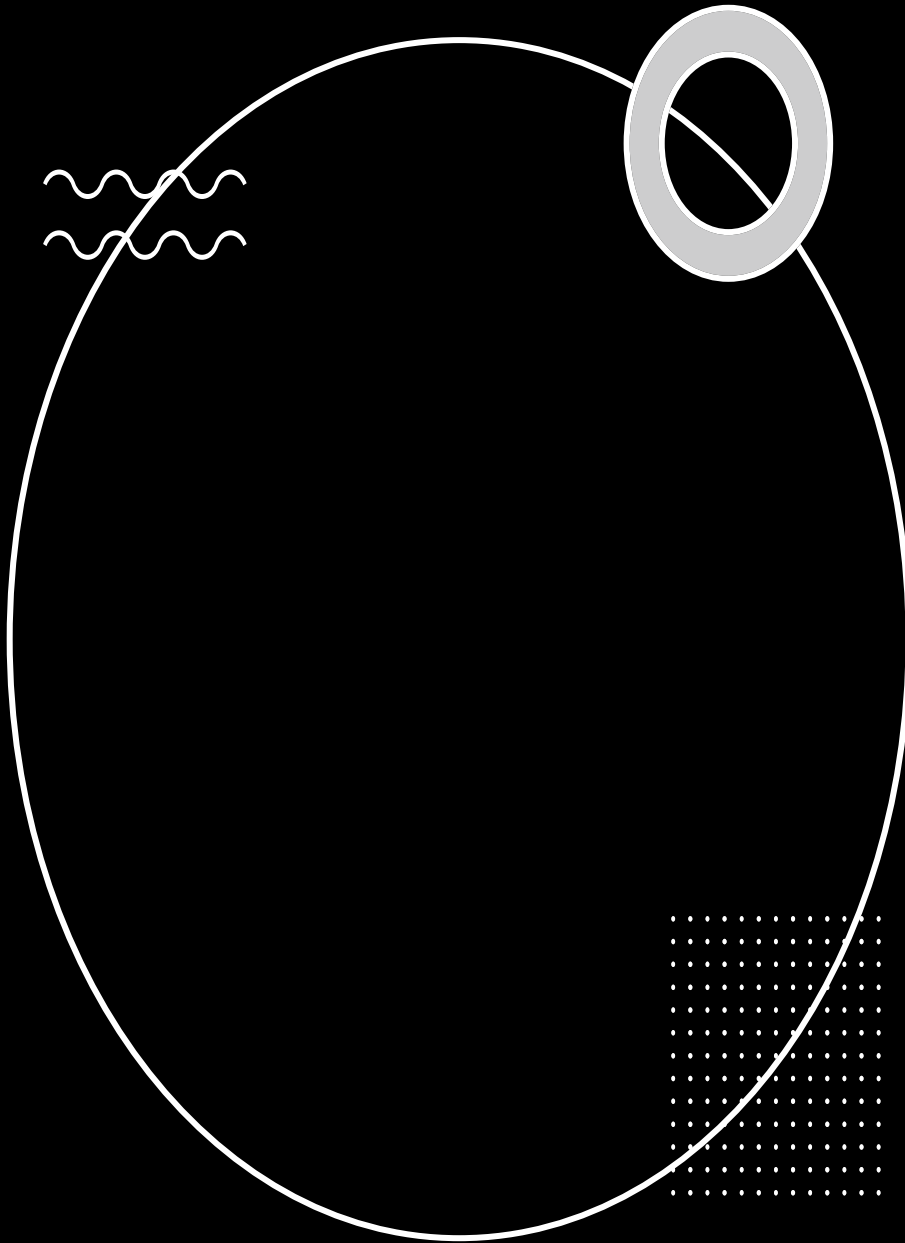
- Don't let the fear of missing out become your driver
