1.1	This paper provides Schools Forum with an analysis of maintained schools revenue accounts for the financial year 2020-21.													
2.0	2019-20 MAINTAINED SCHOOLS REVENUE BALANCES													
2.1	The table below details the 2020-21 year-end revenue balances by phase and makes comparisons to 2019-20. The figures exclude balances relating to community focused activities and cluster funding. Overall Revenue balances have increased across secondary / primary / special schools but decreased for the nursery. The previous year end balances have been adjusted to include only maintained schools as at the end of March 2021. Academy convertors since April 2020 have been removed in order to give a like for like comparison.

2.3	It is our intention to gather this information for Academy schools so we can understand the level of financial resources in our schools. Clearly the impact Covid-19 and uncertainty on future funding has played a role in these levels of balances increasing.														
3.0	BALANCE CONTROL MECHANISM														
	There is currently no requirement for local authorities to operate a Balance Control Mechanism (BCM). Peterborough, in consultation with the maintained schools representatives on Schools Forum, Peterborough has continued to operate a BCM to ensure funding is spent on those children which generated that funding.														
3.2	<ul> <li>The balance control mechanism criteria for 2020-21 was as follows:</li> <li>School balances cannot exceed 8% of their Individual Schools Budget (ISB) share.</li> <li>Revenue balances over this threshold will be clawed back.</li> <li>There will be no distinction between committed and uncommitted balances for the purpose of applying the Balance Control Mechanism.</li> <li>Late funding distributed by the local authority, that the school was unaware of, is deducted from the final revenue balance before applying the balance control mechanism calculation.</li> <li>A panel, consisting of Schools Forum members from the relevant phase, is established to review any appeals prior to the balances being clawed back.</li> <li>It was agreed in Spring 2021 not to apply any clawback at the end of March 2021, this was amended temporarily due to uncertainty relating to COVID 19.</li> </ul>
