# General considerations

- Contextual safeguarding - Ensure your staff understand the safeguarding risks in your school, beyond the national legislations and KCSIE. A quick memo to the staff before the inspection could be helpful!
- Very little mention of COVID!
- Lead the discussions with the inspection team showing clear evidence of how we evaluate our strengths and areas for improvement.
- Data are not looked at, but can be mentioned in discussions.
- If possible, try to predict what pupil, staff and parent may say and devise strategies / answers accordingly.
