Cambridgeshire schools to be congratulated on flu vaccine uptake

Cambridgeshire schools are number one in England for the highest percentage flu vaccination uptake (see table below).

The UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) has published provisional monthly data for 1 September 2025 to 31 January 2025 for the uptake of the seasonal influenza vaccine for children of school age.
