Make, Do and SEND

Recycled, budget and simple ideas to support inclusion of children with SEND



Ducks Posting Box



Materials

- Large shoe box with removable lid
- 2 Ice-cream tubs
- 5 bath ducks

Something to make grass e.g. green packing tape, paper, acrylic paint, or an offcut of fake grass.

How to Make

- Draw round the base of an ice-cream tub on half the box lid.
- Cut shape out so that ice-cream tub sits in the hole.
- Cut a hole in the other side big enough to drop a toy duck in.
- Create grass on top with paint, green tape, paper or fake grass. Tape makes it waterproof as would acrylic paint, the grass looks lovely, but it malts a lot and challenging to stick
- Place another ice-cream tub in box under smaller hole to catch wet ducks.

How to use

- Add water to the ice-cream tub (or blue fabric, water is more fun but consider if it will be too overstimulating) each time a duck disappears drop it into the hole.
- Use in group time to sing five little ducks ensuring all children can see.
- Use as simple a posting box activity, can be used as part of a work box.
- Use 1:1 for children to explore the song and the concept in a structured and concrete way and enabling pauses or appropriate speed to promote engagement.
- Use as a turn taking activity in small group.
- Add numerals 0-5 to identify how many ducks are swimming.
