

Make, Do and SEND

Recycled, budget and simple ideas to support inclusion of children with SEND

Upcycled Story Visuals



Materials

- Old book this can be damaged
- Laminator and laminating sheets
- Coloured paper
- Velcro
- Glue stick

How to Make

- Select pages or images that will support the telling of the story, this will depend on the story e.g. key characters, events, or scenes. For the example of the Bear hunt the main scenes and the characters were used. To supplement this scene strips were added to lay out as a strip. The key sound words were also added to support child's interest in text.
- Stick plain paper on back of and laminate, cut if needed.
- Add Velcro to the back if going to be used on a felt board.



How to use

- Have available in book area in a basket/envelope or on a felt board to support independent access to story exploration.
- Use to support whole group story telling on a felt board to supplement or instead of the book, ensure all children can see.
- Use in whole group time to support individual child to access the group story, handing the images to the child as the story is read, a small felt board can be useful for this.
- Use 1:1 to support access to book by matching images to the pages, you can add Velcro to stick to the matching images on the pages.
- Use scene images to support small world play.
- The images can be mounted on wood and used for small world if resources/ skills are available.
