Delivered by East Anglian Air Ambulance at **no cost to schools**, the engaging **one-hour sessions** will equip pupils with the confidence to **recognise a cardiac arrest, perform bystander CPR and use a defibrillator**, giving them the knowledge and skills that could one day save the life of a family member, friend or member of the public.

This is more than a training session – it is a lasting Knife Angel legacy that will empower thousands of young people across Cambridgeshire to become **lifesavers**.
