PP+ should not go into a general pot for inclusion, SEND or narrowing an achievement gap. It should be utilised to support each individualised child's learning targets (as contained in their PEP). Decisions around the use of it should be driven by priority and need. **Carers should** be involved Provision should be tailored to the pupil's individual needs and strengths Can fund 1/3 of the cost of a residential trip if linked to a PEP **Desirable Outcome** See the full Virtual School PP+ Policy on our website for suggested interventions







PP+ is not a means tested grant and should not be used to provide resources that a Local Authority provides for through its allowance to foster carers or children's home fees.



Pupil Premium Plus (PP+) must not be used to double fund or replace funding which has already been allocated to the school to support the child (e.g. EHCP).
