SEND SERVICES GUIDES

My Reading and Writing Intervention

This intervention is for reading – including understanding, writing, and learning a h/f word. It should take no more than 20 minutes and is ideally carried out a minimum of 3 times a week though preferably 5 times a week.



Brief Outline

A PM Benchmark should be carried out to find the pupil's reading level. Books that are used are then at the appropriate level.



Carry out a high-frequency (h/f) word reading and spelling check.



There are recording sheets in the folder (reference below) with instructions.


- The book is read after warming up the text with appropriate questions asked and recorded on the sheet.
- An unknown word is recorded while the pupil is reading and then one is chosen as the 'target word.' If not suitable choose a h/f word the pupil was unable to spell.
- The pupil puts this word into a sentence, supported with think of a sentence if they need it. Try to keep the sentencing brief.
- Write the sentence and underline the target word
- The pupil practises writing the target word in the box. If it is an irregular word, then use magnetic letters mixed to practise making the word.



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- Ask the pupil to read the sentence and repeat it covering it up.
- With the sentence covered over ask the pupil to write the sentence
- At the next session ask the pupil to write the target on a whiteboard or piece of paper. If correct record this on the spelling chart.
