Understanding Communication

Communication is a 2-way process and is made up of input and output. A minimum of two people is required for communication to happen. To enable communication, you need to gain shared attention and make eye contact
Input:
this is receptive-able and willing to listen
Output:
this is expressive – effectively conveying thought or meaning
Verbal:
can be speech and/or writing
Non-verbal
body language facial expressions sign language symbols visuals
