
Neurodivergent and disabled role models for children and young people

Simone Biles Olympic Gymnast



Has ADHD

- Placed in foster care as a young child and was subsequently adopted by her grandparents
- □ Has won 7 Olympic medals, 4 of which are Gold
- Holds the World Record for six world all-round titles at the Artistic Gymnastics World Championship
- Famously withdrew from events at the Tokyo Olympics due to 'the Twisties' and subsequently took a two year break from gymnastics to focus on her mental health
- Youngest ever recipient of Presidential Medal of Freedom award for her advocacy work for athletes' mental health and foster care children.

□ Left school with two GCSEs in art and geology

- Opened a restaurant that trained young adults from disadvantaged backgrounds
- Initiated the 'feed me better' campaign to improve school meals and was voted 'The Most Inspiring Political Figure' of 2005 for this campaign
- Is the best-selling British non-fiction author since records began
- Appeared on the Sunday Times list of richest Britons under 30

□ Has an MBE for services to the hospitality industry

□ Has ADHD and Dyslexia

- On his last day of school his headteacher told him he'd either end up in prison or would become a millionaire
- □ Is worth approximately \$2.5 billion
- Was placed on Time's most 100 Influential People in the World list
- □ Was knighted for services to entrepreneurship
- Travelled to space on board a test flight for his space flight company Virgin Galactic at the age of 70
- Holds the world record for the fastest Atlantic Ocean crossing by ship

- Has Autism
- □ Is one of the best-selling music artists of all time
- Was placed in Rolling Stones' list of the 100 Greatest Artists Of All Time
- □ Has won 15 Grammy Awards
- Won an Oscar for best original song for Lose Yourself in 8 Mile
- □ Is worth approximately \$250 million
- □ Is in the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame
- Owns his own record label

- □ Is a political activist for climate change and gender equality

- Worked on the Barbie campaign to launch the first Barbie Doll with Downs Syndrome
- Has written and published a book about her life: Against All Odds

Greta Thunberg Environmental Activist




- □ Has autism, OCD and selective mutism
- Addressed the United Nations Climate Change Conference at the age of 15
- Started a movement, that went Worldwide, which involved students striking to get their governments to comply with the Paris Climate Agreement
- □ Sailed from Plymouth to New York on a carbon-free yacht to attend the 2016 United Nations Climate Action Summit
- Was included in Time Magazines list of the 100 most influential people
- □ Has been nominated for the Nobel Peace Prize multiple times

Scientist



- Neurodivergence was not researched during Einstein's lifetime, but modern specialists suggest he had autism, ADHD and dyslexia
- Widely thought of as one of the greatest scientists of all time
 Won a Nobel Prize for physics in 1921
- His formula E = mc², which came from one of his theories, is known as the 'World's Most Famous Equation'
- His achievements have made the word 'Einstein' broadly mean 'genius'
- □ His Theory of Relativity fundamentally changed our understanding of the universe.
