

Asking Questions

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When you share a book with your child it is helpful to ask them questions about it.

You could try asking them some questions similar to the ones on this bookmark.

Examples:

- How did you make it?
- How did you feel?
- What happened next?
- What else could you have used?
- How are these the same?
- What does.....mean?
- Arrange pictures into a sequence?
- Do ‘this’ and then do ‘that’?

Examples:

- What size is it?
- What colour is it?
- What is this part used for?
- What does it taste / feel / smell like?
- What shape is it?
- What do you use it for?
- What is different between the two pictures?
- What are they doing?
- Name something that is food?

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Examples:

- What is it?
- What part is this called?
- Who is this?
- Show me the...?
- Find one like this?
- Where’ s the?
- What did you hear?
- What do you see in the picture?

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Examples:

Why did that happen?
What made it happen?
What would you do different next time?
Why couldn't you do it this way?

What would happen if...?
Why did that happen...?
What could you do?
How can we tell that the boy is sad?
