







## Glossary for Habitats

adapted		Suited to the environment where the organism lives
carnivores		Animals that eat other animals.
chlorophyll		The green pigment in plants that helps plants to make their own food.
consumer		Something that consumes food and doesn't make its own.
excretion		Getting rid of waste from the body eg. sweat, urine or carbon dioxide.
food chain		A way of showing what is food for what.
habitat		Where a plant or animal lives.
herbivore		An animal that only eats plants.
key		A set of questions that help you identify an unknown animal or plant.
nutrition		Getting food in order to grow.
omnivores		Animals that eat meat and plants.
photosynthesis		Making food from carbon dioxide in the air and water in the soil using chlorophyll and sunlight.
predator		An animal that eats other animals.
prey		An animal killed and eaten by a predator.
producer		A living thing that makes its own food using energy from the Sun. i.e a plant.
root		The part of the plant underground that takes in water.
