















Glossary for Moving and Growing

bones		The parts of an animal's body which make the skeleton.
canines		Pointed teeth used for holding and tearing food.
carnivores		Animals that eat other animals.
contract		When a muscle gets shorter.
herbivore		An animal that only eats plants.
invertebrate		An animal without a backbone.
molars		Teeth with flat tops used for grinding food.
muscles		Fleshy parts of the body, joined to bones to make them move. The heart is also a muscle.
omnivores		Animals that eat meat and plants.
organ		A part of the body that does a special job.
relax		When a muscle gets longer.
ribs		The cage of bones in the chest that protect the heart and lungs.
skeleton		The collection of bones which hold the body together, support and protect the organs and help us to move.
skull		The bones that protect the brain.
vertebrate		An animal that has a spine or backbone in its skeleton.
