Course Overview

In this practical course we will look at how we can support and engage the reluctant dancer.

This doesn't necessarily mean boys, this means everyone and anyone who isn't comfortable with dance and moving their body.

- We will explore ways we can encourage them and the strategies you may have already in place within your school, and new ideas you can use.
- We will consider topics that are relevant to children to help get them engaged and to make dance exciting and fun for them.
- We will look at practical ways that children can take ownership of the dances that they create and are part of, be able to work as a team and feel they can express themselves in a safe environment.
- We will look at different ideas of how to make it happen, Eg props, music, themes
- We will also address barriers that may make a dancer reluctant, and how we can support this and potentially break these down.
