- To improve SEND support across Peterborough:
- Training in topics around vision impairment for colleagues working in settings across Peterborough.
- Resource 'Lending Library'.
- Support to individual settings on strategies for supporting children and young people with vision impairments.

• Collaboration with Specialist Teachers of Vision Impairment, Teacher of Multi-Sensory Impairment and Qualified habilitation and mobility specialist.

• Participation in wider projects supporting the needs of SEND learners across Peterborough in partnership with the Local Authority

For our children:

- Inclusive SEND provision for learners with vision impairment.
- Teaching in a mainstream classroom with full access to the mainstream curriculum.
- Access to specialist equipment and resources to support the teaching of the mainstream curriculum if needed.

How do we support children and young people in Peterborough with vision impairment?

- Education of practitioners including SENCOs, teachers and learning support assistants.
- Promotion of best practice across the city and beyond.
- Offering a supportive environment for families to have learning sessions together.
- Opportunities to make contact with other young people with vision impairment.
