1. Upper Cambourne Playground - Choose one piece of play equipment and write some simple instructions for how to use it. Make sure you include any safety warnings.

Follow-up challenge: what do you think is missing in this playground? Design and label an additional piece of play equipment when you return to school.

2. Jeavons Wood School - Look at the board displaying the school name. What is the school's motto? What does this tell you about the school's values? Think of some synonyms for both words in the motto. Use the synonyms to create an alternative motto with a similar meaning.

3. Cambourne Church Centre - Look at the noticeboard outside the church and find the poster advertising the Coffee House. What adjectives are used to describe the Coffee House? Find three verbs which describe what you can do at the Coffee House.

4. Cambourne Community Centre - Why do you think this building is called "The Hub"? Look at the signs on the door. What aren't you allowed to do in the Community Centre?

5. Cambourne Library - Find a sign that tells you that there is piece of life-saving equipment here. What is it called? What clues can you see that tell you what it might be for?

6. Sharman Quinney Estate Agents - Look at the properties for sale displayed in the window and list them in alphabetical order by road name.

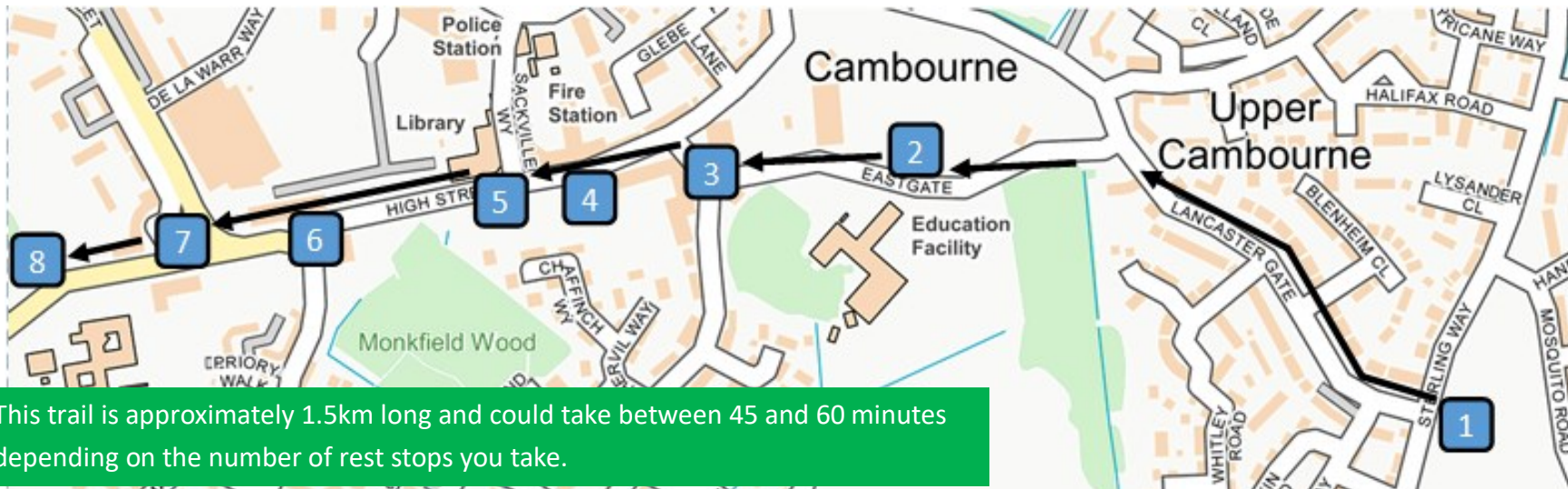
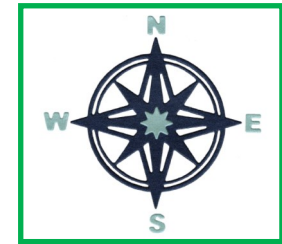
7. Caxton House - Stop outside the "Fish n' Chickn" shop and look carefully at the posters in the window. Can you find three examples of alliteration?
