

Ely Directions



1. Oliver Cromwell's House—Parking is available at Barton Road or Forehill car park, amongst others. Start facing Oliver Cromwell's House, in St Mary's Street. Turn left and walk along Church Lane for approximately 60m to view St Mary's Church.



2. St Mary's Church—Follow the path towards the cathedral grounds, heading east for approximately 100m. You will see the cannon by the side of the path way .



3a and b Ely Cathedral Cannon — Continue for approximately 100m towards the main entrance to the cathedral.

(The admissions information sign can be found in the foyer for the UKS2 trail questions.).



3c Ely Cathedral Entrance— exit the cathedral and walk in a clockwise direction around the footpath of Steeple Row until you find a path on your left after approximately 200m which will lead out onto High Street. Head East along High Street for approximately 30m to Market Place which is opposite the War Memorial. The clock can be found on the Cloisters building.



4. Market Place— Continue East along High Street leading into Fore Hill for approximately 170m. Turn left at the bend onto Waterside and proceed for a further 300m. (Do not cross over the river.)



5a and b Great Ouse Riverside—a) Stay by the riverside. b) You will see the 'Eels form Ely' information map in front of The Maltings. Proceed along the riverside, keeping the River Ouse on your left hand side, in a south westerly direction for approximately 400m until you reach Jubilee Gardens on your right hand side.



7. Jubilee Gardens— The Bandstand and seating area might make a good place for a snack and drink break at the end of the trail. Broad Street can be found on the opposite side of the gardens to the river for the traffic survey.

These directions are based on the assumption that you will follow the trail in the suggested order, however it is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
