

# Huntingdon Directions



**1. Bloomfield Town Park** - To access the park, you could either walk along Brookside (on the ring road) or via the path that starts next to the Cromwell Museum. Whilst you are in the park you could use this as a safe place to conduct a traffic survey.



**2. Riverside Walk**- Exit the park and walk along the pavement keeping the main road on your left. Continue to walk along the ring road until you can cross over at the pelican crossing to reach the riverside. Enter the riverside walk near the playground



**3. Discover Huntingdon For Yourself Map** - Continue to walk right along the path, keeping the River Great Ouse on your left, until you reach the Discover Huntingdon map.



**4. Huntingdon Castle** - At the end of the Riverside Walk, cross the road to the Old Bridge Hotel. Walk along Castle Moat Road to get to the castle mound.



**5. St Mary's Church** - Walk back to the Old Bridge Hotel and cross the road to the High Street. After approximately 100m you will arrive at St Mary's Church on your right.



**6. Bus Station** - At the side of Castle Hill House you will find St Mary's Street. Walk up St Mary's Street and follow the road round to the right to arrive at the bus station.



**7. Library** - After a short walk along Princes Street you will arrive at Huntingdon Library and Archives on your left.



**8. Town Hall** - Continue along Princes Street to the Town Hall.

These directions are based on the assumption that you will follow the trail in the suggested order, however it is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. For example, you may choose to start at the Riverside Car Park or the Town Hall. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
