March Maths Trail

1. St Peter's Church. Parking close by is available in City Road Car Park if needed. Start at St Peter's church on the B1101, which is just north of the roundabout junction with Burrowmoor Road. Almost directly opposite St Peter's church you will find the Museum.





2. Museum. This is perhaps best viewed on the same side of the road as St Peter's Church, without crossing the road, so as to see the full building. Walk approximately 150m north into town, along the B1101 until you reach the Market Place.

3. Market Place. Continue into town along the B1101 and cross the road (pedestrian crossing) after the bridge over the Old River Nene, onto Broad Street. After approximately 500m from the Market Place, you will have found the bus shelter which is set back from the road making this an ideal place for a traffic survey.





4. Bus Shelter. Continue walking north along Broad Street for approximately 200 m and you will see the Fountain in the island in the middle of the road. This is accessible by foot using the pedestrian crossing.

5. Fountain. Retrace your route back along Broad Street for approximately 700m past the Bus Shelter on your right and immediately after crossing the bridge over the Old River Nene you will see a footbath on your right which takes you along the river, through the sensory gardens, to the library.





6. Library. From the library, you could either continue along the river side pathway into West End Park or alternatively continue South and access the park via the front of the George Campbell Leisure Centre.

7. West End Park. This might make an ideal outdoor break area at the end of the trail for children to have a snack and drink before returning to school with the information they have gathered.



It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
