## St Ives Maths Trail



**1. Bus Station** - Start at the Bus Station and use the information on the timetable boards to answer the first question. Then exit the bus station onto Market Road.

**2. Market Hill** - Turn left on Market Road and walk to the junction. At the crossing on your right, cross the road on to Market Hill. Stop at the circular 'timeline'.



**3. The Free Church** - Continue along Market Hill until you get to the Oliver Cromwell Statue and the Free Church URC.

**4. The Quay** - Next to the Free Church, you will find Free Church Lane. Walk along this path until you reach The Quay. Look for a sign showing the cost of mooring a boat.

**5. Bridge Street** - Turn right and walk along the quayside until you reach the historic bridge, at the end of Bridge Street.

**6. Broadway** - Walk back along Bridge Street, then turn left on to Merryland. Continue along The Broadway until you reach the memorial.





**7. The Waits** - Continue west along Broadway until you reach the Norris Museum and The Waits. You will find an information board and benches.

**8. Fire Station** - Continue along the road and follow the road as it bends round to the right. Head north and walk approximately 250m to reach the fire station.





**9. Warner's Park** - To get to Warner's Park you can either use the path from Ramsey Road to Broad Lees (passing Westfield Jnr on your left), or you can follow the route on the map along North Road, then East Street and then left onto Crown Walk.

It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. For example, you may choose to start at Warner's Park or the Fire Station. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
