

# March Directions

**1. St Peter's Church.** Parking close by is available in City Road Car Park if needed. Start at St Peter's church on the B1101, which is just north of the roundabout junction with Burrowmoor Road. Almost directly opposite St Peter's church you will find the Museum.



**2. Museum.** If you need to cross the road to the museum, please use the zebra crossing and then return to the church side before walking approximately 150m north into town, along the B1101 until you reach the Market Place.



**3. Market Place.** Continue into town along the B1101 and cross the road (pedestrian crossing) after the bridge over the Old River Nene, onto Broad Street. After approximately 500m from the Market Place, you will have found the war memorial.



**4 a and b War Memorial area.** Complete the war memorial question. You will see benches and seating opposite the zebra crossing to conduct the survey. Continue walking north along Broad Street for approximately 200 m and you will see the Fountain monument.



**5. Fountain.** Retrace your route back along Broad Street for approximately 700m past the War Memorial and immediately after crossing the bridge over the Old River Nene you will see a footpath on your right which takes you along the river, through the sensory gardens, to the library.



**6. Library.** From the library, you could either continue along the river side pathway into West End Park or alternatively continue South and access the park via the front of the George Campbell Leisure Centre.



**7. West End Park.** This might make an ideal outdoor break area at the end of the trail for children to have a snack and drink before returning to school with the information they have gathered.



These directions are based on the assumption that you will follow the trail in the suggested order, however it is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
