

- 1. St Peter's Church** - Estimate the height of the church door and then the church tower.
- 2. Museum** - Look at this building. Can you find an acute, obtuse, and right angle? Sketch the different shapes and angles you see and name them.
- 3. Market Place** - Find the map and car parking sign. Where is the best place to park if you are visiting Burn Street for at least 3 hours?
- 4a. War memorial** - Estimate the distance from the war memorial to the fountain.
- 4b. Seats opposite the zebra crossing** - Carry out a traffic survey. Decide which information to collect and how to record this so that you can analyse and present your data later.
- 5. Fountain** - Look at the animals on the inside and outside of the fountain frame. How many eyes are there altogether?
- 6. Library** - What is the difference in the time the library is open and staffed on a Tuesday and a Wednesday?
- 7. West End Park** - How many children can sit together on a bench? How many benches would be needed for the whole class?
