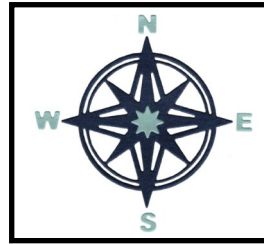


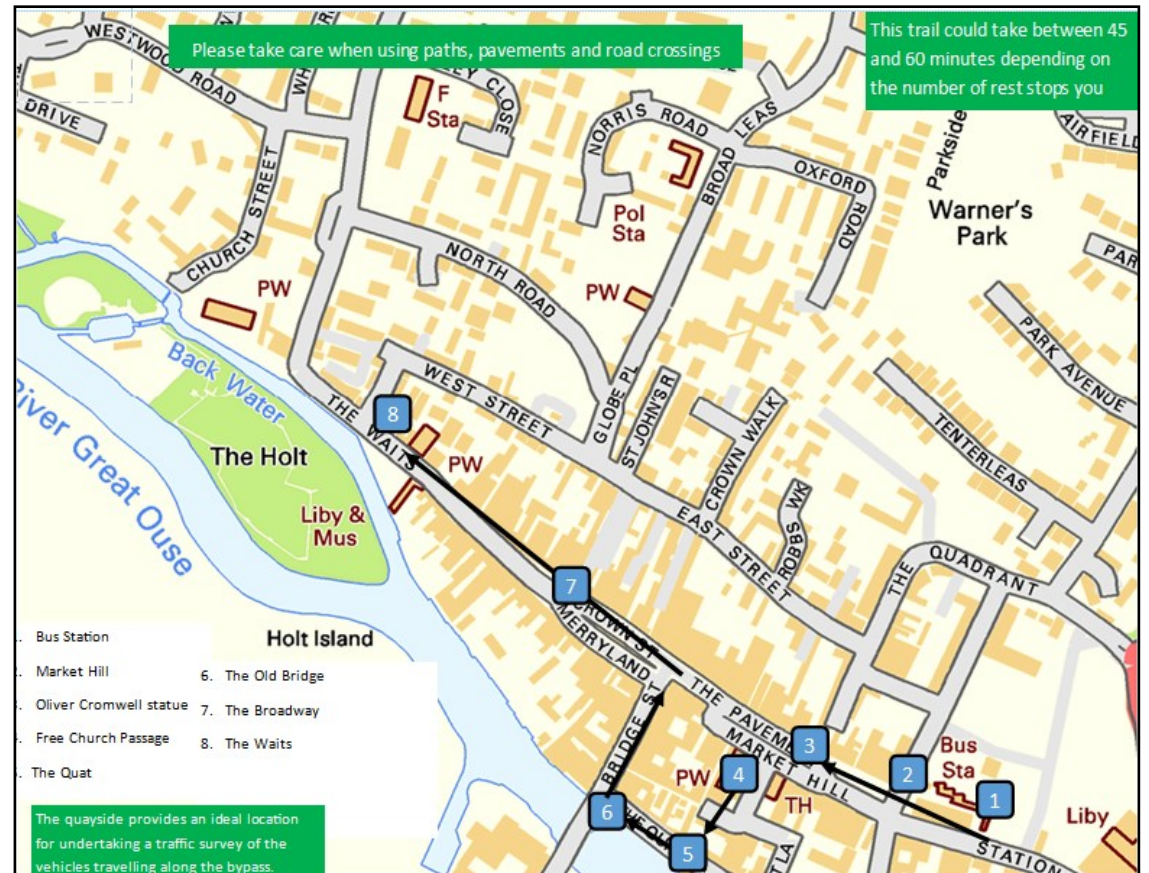
# St Ives Questions

1. **Bus Station**—What is the shortest journey time between Bar Hill Tesco and St. Ives bay 2 on a week day?
2. **Town Time Line**—How many complete decades are there between the earliest and latest years on the time line?
3. **The Free Church** - Estimate the height of the church from the base of the glass doors to the top of the church spire.
4. **Free Church Passage**—Estimate the number of rectangular glass panes in the 5 arched church windows. Explain how you worked out your answer.
5. **The Quay** - Plan and carry out your own survey at the Quay. You could investigate traffic, pedestrians or wildlife.
6. **St. Ives Bridge** - Priya says, “The bridge is longer than the Free Church is tall.” Do you agree or disagree? How would you find out?
7. **The Broadway** - How many weeks were there between the coronation of King Edward VII and the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II?
- 8 **The Waits**
  - a) Look inside the bandstand under the roof. How many kittens in total were there in the rhyme, ‘As I was going to St. Ives’?
  - b) Look at the Methodist Church. Estimate how much of the front of the church is glass. Give your answer as a fraction and a percentage.
