

St Neots Directions



1. Jubilee Gardens - The gardens are also the location for the St Neots village sign and can be found down several steps on the south side of the bridge over the Great Ouse.



2. and 3. Market Place - Head into town along the Hight Street where you will find the pedestrianised Market Place. Care should be taken to be mindful of other members of the public in the large open space, especially if a market is taking place at the time of the visit.



4. Brook Street Bridge - At the end of Market Place, turn right onto South Street. Then follow the road round to the left onto Brook Street. If you cross over the wooden bridge to complete the activity, please remember to return to Brook Street before continuing the trail.



5. St Neots Parish Church - You will find the parish church on the opposite side of the road to the bridge. Walk through the church grounds, past the war memorial and proceed along Church Way to reach the Hight Street.



6. St Neots United Reformed Church - Use the pedestrian crossing to walk over High Street to Moores Walk where you will find the church.



7. Museum - Continue along the High Street towards the in the direction of the river until you reach the next crossroad. Turn right onto New Street and walk for 1 minute to reach the Museum on your right.



8. Library - Return to the High Street and cross over New Street using the pedestrian crossing. Continue towards the river until your reach The Priory road on your right. Continue walking, not taking the turning into Priory Lane, until you reach the library.

It is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
