STATUTORY GUIDANCE TRAINING FOR MAINTAINED SCHOOLS AND ACADEMIES POST 16 AND EARLY YEARS PROVISIONS

<u>Designated Teacher for Children in Care and Previously in Care (Induction Training)</u>

This full day course is an opportunity for newly appointed Designated Teachers to understand the particular vulnerabilities of Children in Care and Children Previously in Care; to examine the role and responsibilities of the Designated Teacher and to look at the legal framework and statutory guidance. The afternoon will revolve around becoming familiar with the PEP, and we will consider the purpose and uses of Pupil Premium Plus funding and how to request it.

RECOVERY THROUGH RELATIONSHIPS

Recovery through Relationships (modular) Train the Trainer

Cambridgeshire Virtual School's Recovery through Relationships training package includes an in-school, bite-size modular programme of learning which includes: Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACES), quietening the brainstem, regulation and relationship, PACE and building your own resilience.

This professional development will enable you to go on a journey with your staff to understand the impact of early childhood trauma. You will learn how through relationships, we can work to help children and young people who have experienced trauma become more regulated and focus back on learning. You will have whole day's training to enable you to deliver six short modules within school staff meetings. You will be given materials, training, and access to termly online support. This approach will give you time to explore ideas and embed new practices in school as you learn. This follows on from and develops the Core Recovery through Relationships headset training. We therefore advise that your staff have had, or are booked to receive, the VR headset training before you attend the modular training.
