

Whittlesey Directions

1. St Andrew's Church - Start at St Andrew's Church, in Church Street. On the opposite side of the road to the church, slightly to the north, follow Barrs Street (the pavement closest to St Andrew's Hall walled garden is wider, although you will also need to cross Parkinson's Lane and Woolpack Lane) for approximately 200m until you come to the junction of Broad Street and Market Street. The Library / Community Hub can be found a further 20m along Market Street, on your right.



2. Library / Community Hub— Cross over to the opposite side of Market Street and head east for approximately 70m, where you will find the Museum / Town Hall on your left hand side.



3. Museum / Town Hall — Continue along Market Street for a further 150m where you will then see the War Memorial in the central island of Queen Street.



4. War Memorial — The Market Square and Buttercross can be found by crossing over Market Street onto the partially pedestrianised area. You will also see a range of benches here.



5. Market Square / Buttercross — Standing under the Buttercross and facing westwards, you will see a lane. Follow this for 50m and you will find yourself in St Mary's Churchyard.



6. St Mary's Church — Continue to follow the path towards and then alongside St Mary's Church. Cross straight through the car park, on the same path, heading east until you reach Station Road. Turn right and after approximately 30m you will see the Garden of Rest on the opposite side of the road.



7. Garden of Rest — It may be easier to cross back to the opposite side of Station Road before heading south, away from the town centre, toward the Manor Leisure Centre. Continue for approximately 275m, crossing Manor View along the way, where you will find the entrance to the Manor Leisure Centre (and plaque with useful information).



8. Manor Leisure Centre— In the Manor Leisure Centre, there are 5 parking bays near the Bowls Club. There is no need to walk around to the larger car park to complete the activity.



These directions are based on the assumption that you will follow the trail in the suggested order, however it is possible for you to start at any of the points on the trail and follow the route in any direction as you wish. If you decide to start at a different point, please take this into consideration when following the directions above.
