1. St Andrew's Church

Look at this building. Sketch the different shapes you see and name them. Record the time shown on the church clock.

You will need all of this information recorded for when you get to St Mary's Church later in the trail.

2. Library / Community Hub

Is the library open longer on a Tuesday or a Saturday?

For how many hours is this building open in total per week?

3. Museum / Town Hall

Which is open the most during a week, the library or the museum? By how much? Look at the Heritage Board outside the museum.

What fraction of mud walls are registered as listed buildings?

4. War Memorial

Estimate the number of gold railing tops around the outside of the war memorial. Explain your strategies.

5. Market Square / Buttercross

Estimate how many benches would be needed for the whole class to sit. Here is a good place to conduct a traffic survey. Decide which information to collect and how to record this so that you can present and analyse your data later.

6. St Mary's Church

Record the time shown on the church clock. How long ago were you outside St Andrew's church?

Record shape similarities and differences between this building and St Andrew's Church.

7. Garden of Rest


Estimate the height of the Straw Bear statue.
