1. St Andrew's Church

Look at this building. Sketch the different shapes and angles you see and name them. Record the time shown on the church clock.

2. Library / Community Hub

For how many hours is this building **not** open in total per week?

3. Museum / Town Hall

What would be the most accurate way of estimating the number of bricks that would be needed to seal both arches previously used for fire engines? How would you describe the tiled pattern seen beneath the Town Hall arch?

4. War Memorial

What is the most common surname recorded on the war memorial? Are there more single initial or double initial names? Explain how you know.

5. Market Square / Buttercross

Look at the floor underneath the Buttercross. Estimate the ratio of black tiles to white tiles. Explain your strategies.

Conduct a traffic survey. Decide which information to collect and how to record this so that you can present and analyse your data later.

6. St Mary's Church

How long has it taken you to get to St Mary's church?

Record shape and angle similarities and differences seen between this and St Andrew's Church.


7. Garden of Rest

Use your stride length to estimate the perimeter of the rose beds surrounding the Straw Bear statue.

8. Manor Leisure Centre

Look at the entrance gates. How many days, months and years since the Manor Playing Field was opened by Alderman Anthony?

Use the number of paving bricks in the larger parking bays to estimate how many similar bricks would be needed to block pave one of the smaller bays. This might make a good location for a snack and drink break before returning to school.



Extra challenge: On your trail you will find or pass several plaques. Each plaque records a year in which a historic event happened. Record each year that you see and then write them in chronological order from oldest to most recent event.
