2. St Peter's Church—Record the time shown on the clock face. How much time has passed since you were at the bus station?

3. Museum—What would be a good way to estimate the number of panes of glass used in the windows?

4. Castle—For how long was the building in use as the Bishop's Palace?


5. Library—Is the library open for longer on Tuesday or Saturday? By how much?

6. War Memorial—Approximately what fraction of the total number of names on the war memorial are displayed at the front? What is the most common first name displayed on all of the sides?

7. Clarkson Memorial—Look at this monument. Can you find an acute, obtuse and right angle? Sketch the different shapes and angles you see and name them.

8. Wisbech Lions Gardens—How old was William Carlisle when Elizabeth Carlisle was born?
