2. St Peter's Church— What time is shown on the clock face of the church? What time is shown on the sundial above the main entrance to the church? Why might these times differ during the year? What is the same and what is different about the clock face and the sundial?

3. Museum—Estimate the height of the museum doors. Estimate the height of the museum building. Explain your strategies.

4. Castle—How long ago was this the site of Thurloe's Mansion? Record your answer in years, months and days.


5. Library— Kelly says the library is open for the equivalent of 2 days per week. Do you agree? Explain your answer.

6. War Memorial— Estimate the length of the perimeter of the bottom step. How can you use this to estimate the perimeter of the other steps?

8. Wisbech Lions Gardens—Who lived longer, William or Elizabeth Carlisle?
